

VEHICLE TITLES or CONFIRMATION OF OWNERSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

If you own any vehicles, including boats, motorcycles, ATV's, etc., we will need a copy of either your vehicle title(s) or Confirmation of Ownership document. Either of these documents prove your ownership of a vehicle(s) to the bankruptcy trustee who administers your case. A vehicle registration document is not acceptable by the trustee. If you financed the purchase of your vehicle, the creditor holds the title. When you pay off the loan, the creditor will deliver the title to you. If you do not have a copy of your title, you can obtain a document called "Confirmation of Ownership" from the DMV by calling (608) 264-7447 and enter Option #2. A DMV representative will send you an application to obtain the Confirmation of Ownership form.
